Principal's Report

EQAO grade 9 math this week, test is worth 10% of each student's final mark.

Arts Night went well and was comprised of visual arts, drama and music

Relay for Life - partnered with Jean Vanier to successfully raise over \$60,000.00 as well as awareness of the cause.
